- Relative unknown
- •Small/Scattered or associated in wetlands
- Threats by increasing land demands/exploitation by investors
- Lack of specific management laws






- 2010 Asean Peat Management Strategy and Training of trainer manual translated into Lao.
- •2011-12 Assessment survey in Vientiane Province and Champasack province conducted.
- •Evolving of basic knowledge on peatland
- To date only a single site, a wetland Bueng Kiat Ngong, in Pathoumphone District, Champasack Province identified as peatland with 400 ha.
- Three sites in Vientiane province, have some but in-complete criteria (low OM content/low depth)
- Recognition of peatland mportance lues).


